Taiwan Lourdes Association (TLA)

Taiwan Lourdes Association was established by the Daughters of Charity since 1960s known as “Lourdes Home” and dedicated in caring for the orphans and disadvantaged children. At 1997, the association had seen the massive influence of HIV/AIDS toward those people who are infected and their families. “Lourdes Home” started to switch their works to the HIV/AIDS agenda and officially registered as a NGO at 2006. The goal of the organization is to improve the quality of life of people living with HIV/AIDS

(PLWHA) through various care and support services and programs. The Association advocates for human rights of PLWHA, provide community-based services for PLWHA and empowering PLWHA to develop into well human being.

During 2017:

- GSK provided an unrestricted grant of NTD\$501,000 for screening program and education activities.

During 2016:

During 2015:
